Take a safari through the sunshine state

Visitors to the Orlando area tend to find it difficult to look beyond the overwhelming marketing operations for the theme parks and attractions.

Yet just 60 minutes drive from Orlando Forever Florida is a 4,700 acre eco-ranch and wildlife conservation area that is truly natural Florida.

It is from here that Florida EcoSafaris operates zipline, coach and horseback safaris.

The safaris give visitors the chance to enjoy streams, forests, pastures and wetlands, and to learn about and spot a wide array of birds and animals including alligators and white-tail deer.

AllWays travellers looking to experience the manufactured thrills of the umpteen theme parks should try to fit in at least one day of natural beauty and excitement at Forever Florida.

The Allen Broussard Conservancy

The Allen Broussard Conservancy was founded for the purpose of purchasing the land, known as Forever Florida, and keeping it as a wildlife preserve.

The Conservancy is named after Allen David Broussard, a wildlife biologist and ecologist, who died aged 29.

His parents William and Margaret founded the Conservancy in Allen's memory and a substantial portion of proceeds from Forever Florida go toward the purchase of additional lands to be conserved.

The 4,700 acres that form the *Forever Florida* conservation area takes in nine distinct Florida ecosystems and a wide range of natural flora and fauna including alligators, black bears and nearly two hundred species of birds.

There is also just the chance of spotting the endangered Florida panther.

Coach Safari



The two-hour coach safari takes a trip through a Florida ranch, featuring a living museum of Spanish Colonial Cattle and Florida's unique Cracker Horses, before heading off into the conservation area.

The tour goes over land and water onboard special open air safari coaches, elevated five-feet off the ground.

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Zipline Safari



The zipline safari, the only one in Florida, provides a two and a half hour journey soaring at speeds up to 25 mph through Pine Flatwoods and forested wetlands, 55 feet off the ground.

This really is as exciting as it sounds.

The starlight or moonlight zipline safaris allows visitors to enjoy the experience under a blanket of stars.

Horseback Safari



Forever Florida has some of the best horseback riding in Central Florida, taking in historic trails that were first ridden by native Americans in the 1500's.

The one and two hour rides include a trip through the headwaters of Bull Creek. Overnight rides are also available.

Horses are personally matched to each individual's personality and level of riding experience so first - timers are welcome.
