Adelboden: majestic mountains everywhere in this stunning Alpine resort



Adelboden is a traditional mountain village at the end of the Engstligen valley in the Bernese Oberland region of the Swiss Alps.

The road ends at Adelboden but there are cable cars and ski lifts to take visitors up to some of the most spectacular Alpine scenery.

From December to early-May, Adelboden's snow covered mountain slopes are a magnet for winter sports enthusiasts.

From June to October, the mountainsides turn into a lush green tapestry of grass that carpets the area. It is then the walkers and bikers who come to Adelboden.

Adelboden, is yet to be as well known as some of the other Swiss mountain resorts - and it is this that makes a visit all the more enjoyable.
